## Course Routing Trial

In line with the promise made to members when the new holes were introduced, the Course Management Committee and the Members Operating Committee have decided over the next two weeks to trial playing the course as per the old layout starting from the 10th. Clearly this will include playing the current 12th and 18th holes as they are a par 4 and a par 3. This trial will not address all the issues that have been raised regarding the course since the changes but determining the route of each 9 will be a good start.

The trial will start on Monday 16th, it will not operate on Tuesday 17th and Wednesday 18th as there are qualifying competitions but will then run until Sunday 29th October. Temporary cards will be provided in the locker rooms and the Pro Shop as will feedback forms. Completing a feedback form is really important as the information gained will be used in assessing what if anything we do regarding the layout of the course in the future.

The routing being trialed using the existing hole numbering is as follows

Front 9: holes number 10,11,12,13,14,6,7,8 and 9

Back 9: holes number 1,2,3,4,5,15,16,17,and 18


