## Captains Away Days 2017



Following the very successful 2016 Captains Away Trip the plans are already underway for the 2017 version.

A provisional booking has been made at the exclusive Q Hotel venue of Forest Pines in Lincolnshire. Those of you that have had the opportunity of playing here before will surely welcome a return, and those who have yet to visit, have a real treat awaiting them.

There are 3 very different and very beautiful nine hole courses and we will play all three of them across the two days of the trip.

We have secured a terrific deal to include bacon rolls, tea and coffee on arrival on the Sunday before playing 18 holes of golf on the Beeches and Forest courses with tee times from 12:30pm. Dinner on the evening is included and will either be a choice from a set menu or a rolling buffet from a menu that will include a similar number of choices. A drinks package of 20% discount off the hotel prices has been secured, so yet again, the more you drink the more you save! Following the night's accommodation and a full breakfast, golf will re-commence from 10:00am on the Monday on the Forest and Pines courses. At the end of the golf there will be a bowl of chips awaiting before you drive back home.

The date of this extravaganza is earlier than this year on Sunday 17th and Monday 18th September 2017. Tee times will be restricted and there is a need to secure this opportunity before the 20th October this year with confirmation of numbers and a holding deposit. If we don't do this in time we are likely to see an increase in price and a restricted number of tee times.

The cost will be £135 per golfer in a twin room with a £30 single player supplement.
