

Rules Governing Membership Subscriptions and Membership Categories
Updated December 2015

1. All membership subscriptions for all membership categories cover a twelve month period from the first day of the month of annual renewal or of joining the Club. Members who elect to pay monthly by prior arrangement with the Club remain liable for all monthly payments irrespective of whether they continue to use that membership.
2. Members who have not made payment by the fifteenth day of the month of renewal shall lose access to the courtesy of the golf course, unless paying the current green fee. If payment has not been made by the last day of that month, membership will be assumed to have lapsed.
3. Members whose subscription category is related to age (e.g. juniors and members between the ages of 19 and 35 years) will be billed at the rate appropriate to their age at date of renewal or joining.
4. Members who wish to change the category of their golf-playing membership may apply to the Club Manager to make this change at the date of their renewal. Such changes will be subject to the availability of spaces within the category concerned.
5. Members who wish to change the category of their golf-playing membership during the course of their subscription year may apply to the Club Manager. Such a change will be subject to:
 - 5.1. The availability of spaces in the category concerned.
 - 5.2. The forfeit of any “unused” paid-up fees, when moving to a lower subscription rate category.
 - 5.3. The payment, pro-rata, of any additional fees when moving to a higher subscription rate category.
6. Members, or former members, not currently subscribing to a golf-playing membership, may apply to the Club Manager to join or to re-join a golf-playing category. Such an application will be subject to:
 - 6.1. The availability of spaces in the category concerned.
 - 6.2. Payment in full of the twelve months’ subscription appropriate to that category on the date of resuming or taking up a golf-playing membership.
 - 6.3. Payment of the charge or entrance fee ruling in that subscription year.
7. On the basis of substantiated medical grounds (most usually to undertake surgery), a member may apply to suspend his or her golf-playing membership for a period of time. Subject to the approval of the Members Operating Committee, such a member will temporarily join the “Returning Member” category and the following shall apply:
 - 7.1. Any “unused” paid-up fees shall be deducted from the subscription fees due at the time of resuming his or her golf-playing status.
 - 7.2. If golf-playing status is resumed after the normal annual renewal date for that member, the member shall pay the appropriate and prevailing twelve months’ subscription minus any credit accrued as per 7.1.
