GRANT AWARDS

Financial assistance will be awarded in three categories: Specific Knowledge or Skills Programs, Entrepreneurial Ventures and Degree Attainment.

We live in a complex interactive society and we must recognize the importance and value of all careers and professions within our communities. A variety of vocations are necessary to maintain and develop an efficient and effective society that meets the demands and enhances the day to day lives of its people.



APPLICATION PROCESS

The Fouché Foundation Fund provides financial assistance in three categories to individuals with a vision and determination to attain a vocation. They are:

- 1. **Specific Knowledge or Skill Training Program** (i.e. Technical training as electrician, pet groomer, teacher's assistant, automotive mechanic, respiratory therapist, care provider, etc. (Must be currently enrolled and in last phase of training)
- 2. **Entrepreneurial Venture:** Business (i.e.) Service Industry/Products: health/child care, restaurant, tax preparer, medical/dental practice, tutoring. Products: hair goods, tailor, landscape and etc. (Must be a 501(c) (3) and have been in business at least one year)
- 3. **Degree Attainment:** Chemist, Veterinarian, Teacher, Computer Programmer, (Must be currently enrolled and in the last semester/quarter).
