

**EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HOMEWOOD, ALABAMA**

July 6, 2020

The City Council of the City of Homewood, Alabama convened in Emergency Session on Monday, July 6, 2020 at City Hall at 2:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by President Wright at 2:05 p.m., after which the pledge of allegiance was given.

Upon Roll Call, the following were present: Britt Thames, Mike Higginbotham, Walter Jones, Barry Smith, Alex Wyatt, Jennifer Andress, John Hardin, and Peter Wright constituting a quorum of Council members. Andrew Wolverton logged into the meeting via Zoom. Also present were: Mike Kendrick, City Attorney; and Melody Salter, City Clerk; and J.J. Bischoff, Chief of Staff. Absent: Andy Gwaltney and Patrick McCluksy.

The sole item on the Agenda was Item No. 01.06.20 – Request for consideration of extending a city wide curfew – President Wright.

President Wright asked Mayor Scott McBrayer to address the Council.

Mayor Scott McBrayer addressed the Council regarding this item.

Captain Ben Sutton of the Police Department addressed the Council regarding this item.

The Council then held discussion regarding this item.

At this time, Mr. Kendrick presented the following Resolution for the Council's consideration.

Resolution No. 20-79

(A Resolution extending and amending the city wide curfer for 9:00 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. and set to expire on June 9, 2020 at 4:30 a.m.)

Councilor Wolverton moved for the adoption and enrollment of Resolution No. 20-79. Councilor Thames seconded the motion.

President Wright asked if the Council had any questions or comments regarding the motion. There was no response from the Council.

On a voice vote, the motion carried on a vote of 7-2. Councilors Jones and Higginbotham voted no.
