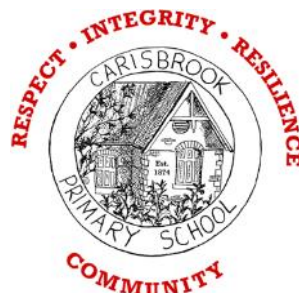

Carisbrook Primary School Camps 2020

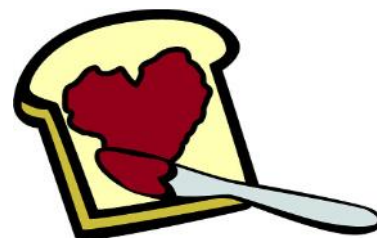
