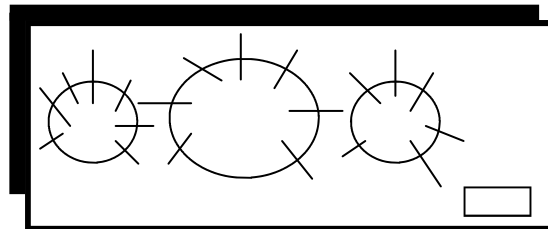

Ribbon: Champion of Parchment Craft

The basics of parchment craft are embossing and perforating work carried on translucent "parchment" paper. This is a revival of a 15th century ecclesiastical craft that many people enjoy today. By rubbing and embossing the tool on the back paper, you can displace the fibres and the paper changes colour from grey white to snow white and are raised.

The use of needle tools to mark perforated edges and lace work is the hallmark of the craft. All Work is traced onto parchment paper from patterns.
