The Bradford Ornithological Group was formed in 1987 to bring together birdwatchers, whatever their experience, who are interested in the birds of Bradford and the surrounding area.

The aims of the Group include promoting the welfare and study of birds in the Bradford area and the conservation of habitats of value to birds. The Group has established one reserve near Keighley and has also arranged access to a private Yorkshire Water reservoir site.

Our Group Meetings are held on the first Tuesday each month at 7.30pm at the Baildon Community Link Centre, 35 Cliffe Avenue, Baildon BD17 6NX. We normally have a guest speaker or a presentation given by one of our own members. We also discuss recent bird sightings in the Bradford area and as it is a good opportunity to socialise with other local birders.

Annual membership of the Group is £20 for individuals or £30 for a family membership. Members will receive by e-mail the Bradford Ornithological Group Annual Report. All subscriptions are due on the 1st May. (Applications for new membership received during January to April will include membership for all of the following year).
