This SULADS News Journal is published through the joint efforts of the SULADS Main Office Staffs.

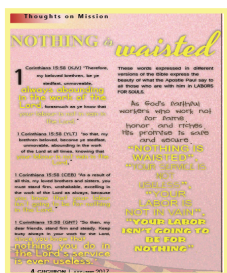

15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

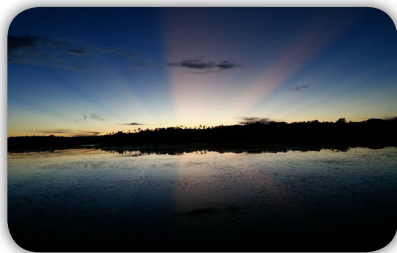
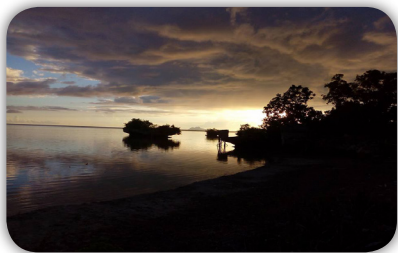
16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

What a beautiful life, what a beautiful promise for those faithful feet in the highways, hedges, mountains and the islands!

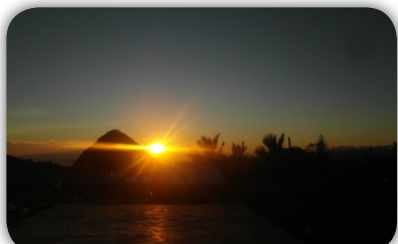

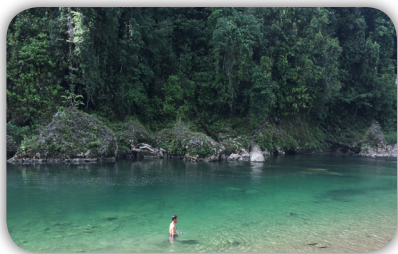

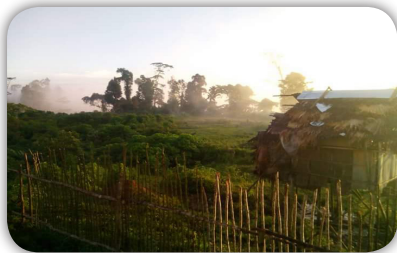

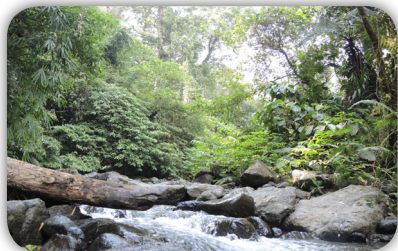

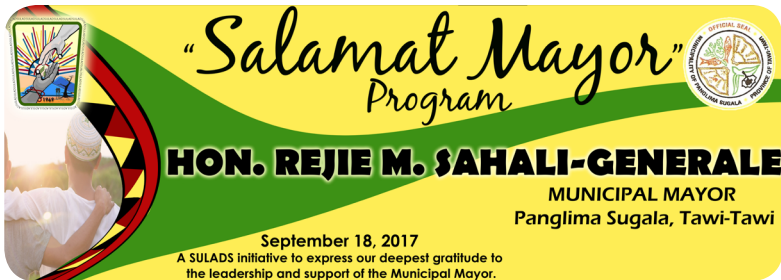

SULADS initiates **Salamat Mayor** Program



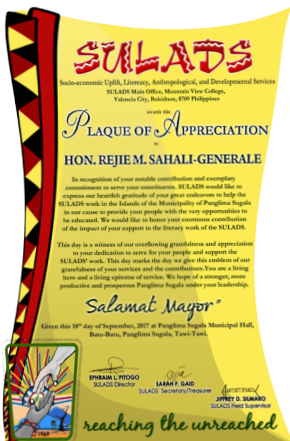

Strengthening not just their academic performance but most of all their values, because SULADS missionaries do not just teach, they change lives!

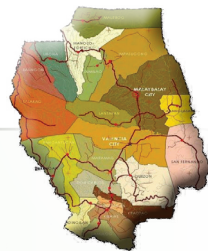

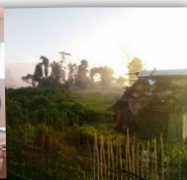

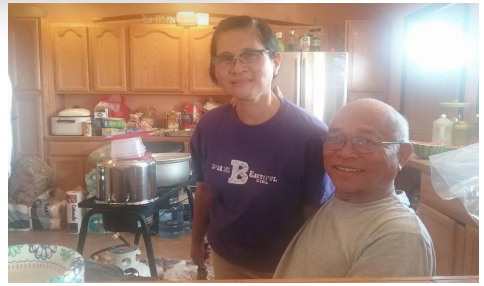
