- A sleeping bag

Camp Rules

1. No abuse of any kind will be tolerated. Treat others with kindness and respect and build each other up.
2. No destruction to property or other's belongings.
3. No smoking, drugs, or alcohol.
4. No MP3s, iPod, video games or any other device. Camp counselors will have alarm clocks. No cell phones (there is very little reception at the campsite).
5. Any prescription or over-the-counter (OTC) medicines must be in the original container with the youth's name, drug name, and dosage amount and time clearly labeled. ALL medicines MUST be given to an FLC leader. BE sure that you also include all the information on the trip applications.
6. No one may leave the general campsite area without an FLC / AA adult leader.
10. Use of vulgar language or obscene gestures will not be tolerated.

There are NO warnings! Any violations of rules and parents will be called and you will be sent home.

Pick up will be at the camp ground at 12pm, Friday the July 24th . Please be prompt in picking up your camper as our adult leaders have had an AWESOME but LONG week. If you are unable to pick up your teen please arrange for someone else to give them a ride
