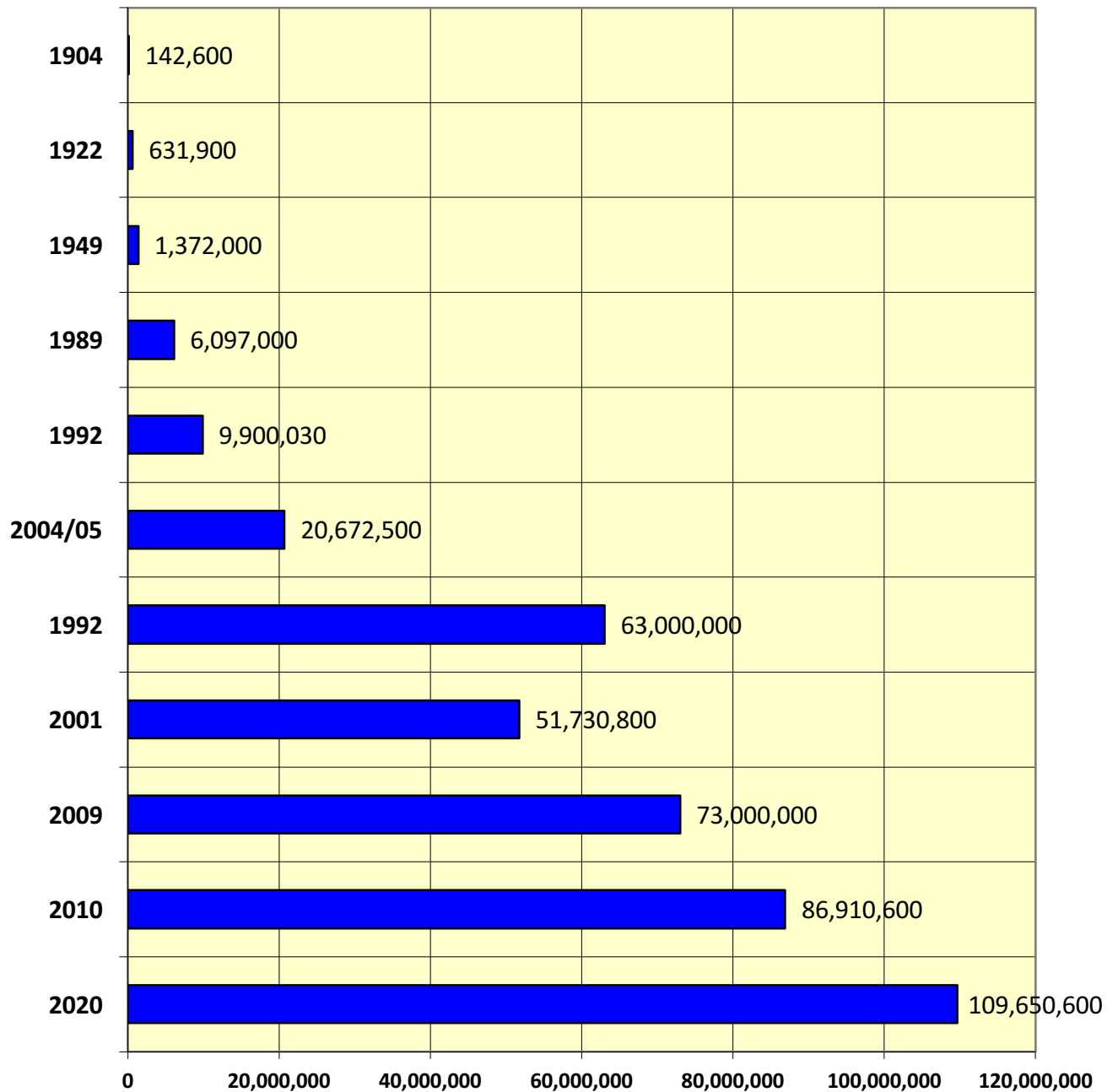


## EVANGELICAL CHRISTIANS IN CHINA (1904-2020)
