Subject: declaration about UE Directives and Regulations

2011/65/UE Directive

This is to inform you that chemicals substances mentioned into 2011/65/UE Directive are not used in the formulation of raw materials used in the production of our tubing supplied to your Company, as stated in Test report from independent labs.

We also inform you that, since the raw materials supplier nor the tube manufacturer has any influence on sequent manufacturing phases, the final conformity of the product is due to the final user. We do not routinely check the presence of the chemical substances in our products, but our procedures permit to exclude their presence.

REACH Regulation 1907/2006

We also inform you that, according to 1907/2006 Regulation (REACH), Guaine Micoplast s.r.l. is a downstream user (DU) manufacturer of articles. Since the articles produced by our Company does not intentionally release any substances, therefore no registration is required. Nevertheless, we have started a series of actions with our suppliers in order to fulfill our obligations inside the supply chain.

- 1. All our suppliers of plastic materials have confirmed that they or their own suppliers will register the substances in their preparations;
- 2. All our suppliers have confirmed they will supply the registration numbers of the substances included in their preparations as soon as they become available;
- 3. According to the declarations of our suppliers and/or the information provided in their updated SDS, none of the raw materials used to produce our articles contain any substance classified as VHC, last edition, in quantity greater than 0.1% w/w. See also ECHA web site for the most updated list
