Memory Card Game

This game can be played individually at a station, or by the whole group, taking turns.

Activity:

First, match each character to its treasure, as a simple puzzle.

Then, turn all the cards over and mix them up. Turn over two cards at a time. If the cards are a matching character and treasure, collect them. If not, the next player takes a turn.

Questions:

Whose treasure is this?

How might this character (whether matching or not) use this treasure?
