**HONOLULU** - <u>www.hawaiivein.com</u> - The Vein and Skin Center of Hawaii (VSH) today announced an innovative new treatment that helps enhance hair density without surgery and prevents future hair loss. This new procedure is now available in Hawaii exclusively at the Vein and Skin Center of Hawaii. The patient's own platelet rich plasma (PRP) is used with a prescribed supplement protocol, resulting in outstanding results on the mainland, increasing the thickness of the hair and triggering hair growth. PRP is a high concentration of platelets surrounded in its own plasma, supporting the body's healing abilities, with quick recovery time for patients.

"PRP for hair restoration involves a simple injection of platelets into the scalp," said Dr. W.Y. Chung MD, founder and chief medical officer of the Vein and Skin Center of Hawaii. "This treatment increases blood supply to the hair follicle, stimulating hair growth, increasing thickness and decreasing hair loss."

When a patient arrives, Dr. Chung takes a small sample of blood from the patient, and spins it down to create the PRP while the patient is prepped for the procedure. An anesthetic solution, or chiller, is applied to the patient's scalp and then Dr. Chung completes the PRP scalp injection. The entire process takes about five to 10 minutes.

"There is virtually no downtime or long recovery process," Dr. Chung said. "Patients are able to shower the same night of the treatment, and we advise patients to refrain from using any harsh dyes or chemicals on the hair for at least 48 hours."

According to Dr. Chung, usually three to four PRP injections are necessary over the course of four

months, with significant results visible within six to eight months.

"PRP for hair restoration is most effective on patients who have been diagnosed with androgenic

alopecia, a genetic condition that causes hair loss," Dr. Chung said. "A detailed consultation will help to

determine this, and we work with the patient to create a customized treatment plan."

Pricing can vary based on customized treatments, but starts at about \$500 a session.
