How To...

Report a Microchip Number on the paper Registration Application

This **method** is for those breeders and owners who are sending the **original paper** registration application back down to The Jockey Club, directly or via the CTHS.

*Remember the microchips are not linked to a horse until you indicate that a specific microchip has been implanted.


You will receive your microchip with your registration application kit.

- 1. Write the year of birth and dams name on the back of the microchip package.
- 2. Implant the microchip in the horse (either in the "nasal area" or the neck nuchal ligament).
- 3. Place a bar code sticker provided in each of these locations (a & b):
 - a. On the front of the Registration Application
 - b. And in the "microchip box" found on the identification markings side of the registration application (the back).
 - i. **If it is a nasal microchip implant**, write "nasal" beside the bar code sticker.
- 4. To report the microchip number and location to the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (CTHS), National Office:
 - a. Place a bar code sticker on the "Declaration for foals born in Canada"
 - b. Please indicate the location of the microchip implant.
 - c. Mail the Canadian Declaration and associated fees to the National Office.






