If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

#### BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. Collecting & coordinating vital statistics and information for obituary publication
- 2. Contacting (via email) local and out of town newspaper for obituary placement
- 3. Obtaining & completing death certificate from appropriate signer & filing with local agent
- 4. Retrieving certified copies of death certificate
- **5.** Notifying Social Security, Life Insurance Companies, Veterans Associations & coordinating Military Honors if desired
- **6.** Preparing other legal authorizations for final disposition
- 7. Professional licensed funeral director on staff to perform embalming procedure or cremation service
- **8.** Professional licensed funeral director to conduct services & visitations
- 9. Coordinating time of services & visitation
- 10. Coordinating services with clergy & church facilities
- 11. Coordinating cemetery plans
- 12. Valet parking for services & visitations
- 13. 24 hour availability, 7 days a week

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangement you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains).

#### **Cash Disbursements - Additional Expenses**

Arranging the funeral ceremony and committal often requires the funeral home to pay others on your behalf. We do not charge for this service. Examples of the people who may expect payment in advance include the cemetery, church/synagogue or clergy. Often the timing of the funeral arrangements - hour, date, or holidays - may make it necessary for us to estimate what advances you want us to make on your behalf. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

#### **EMBALMING** (*Including use of preparation room and sanitary care*)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. N.J.A.C. 13:36-9.16 & 9.17

If you chose to have an embalming performed, the decedent may be embalmed at a location other than this registered mortuary. N.J.A.C. 13:36-9.16

No human remains may remain unburied or uncremated in New Jersey for more than 48 hours unless embalmed or refrigerated. (N.J.A.C. 8:9-1.1)
