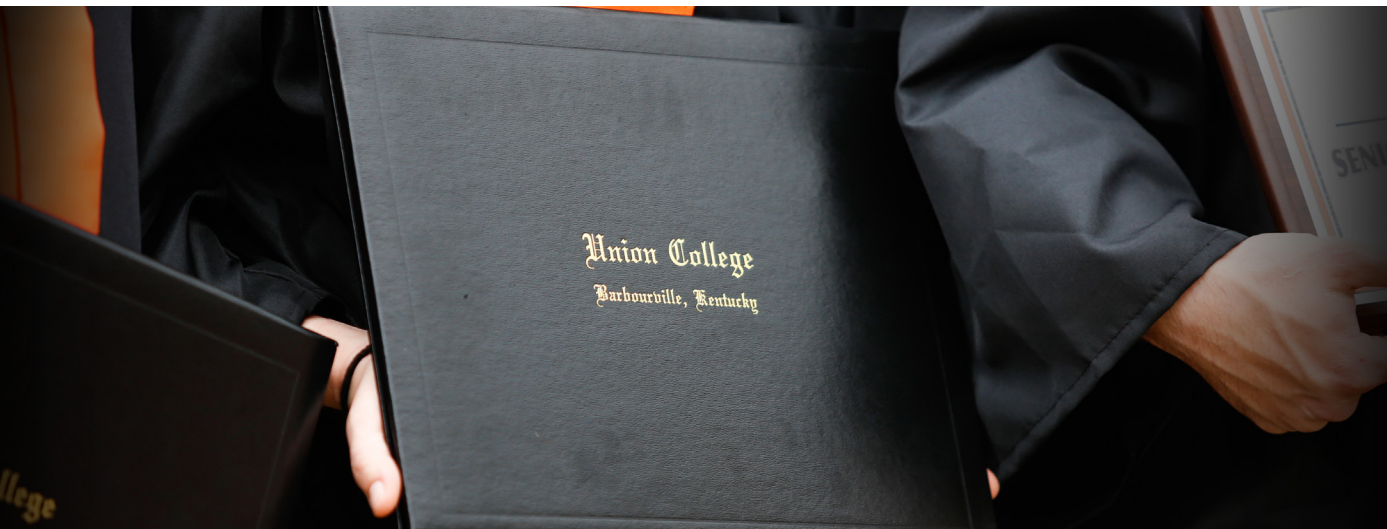

DUAL MASTERS PROGRAM

The Union College Dual Masters Program is designed to provide students the opportunity to earn two graduate degrees in just 8 short semesters. Classes are completed on eight-week schedules and offered in a delivery mode that is completely online. All graduate programs require 12 credit hours of core management coursework coupled with discipline specific courses, allowing overlap for those seeking multiple degrees.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

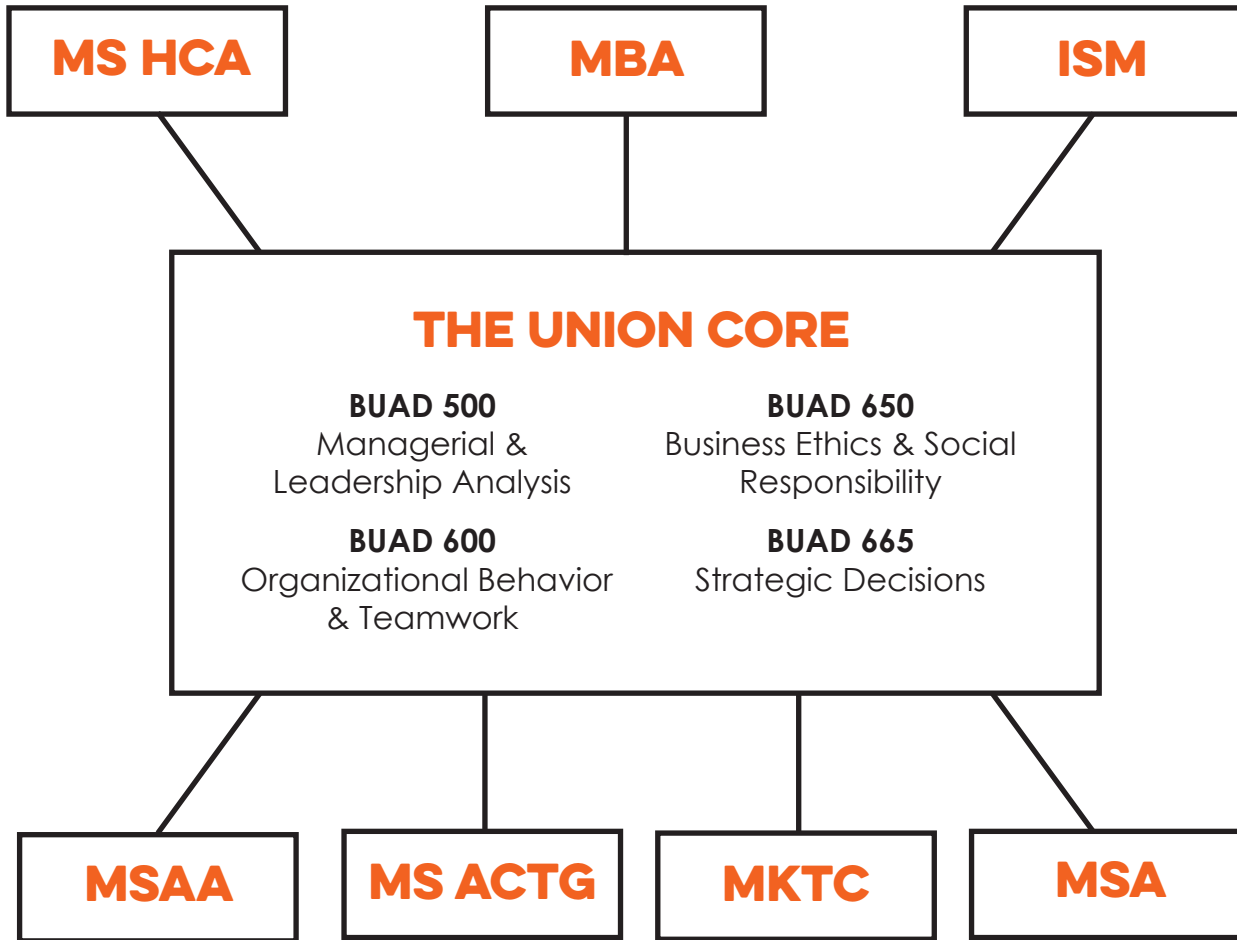
- Successful completion of required program courses - we will accept up to 6 transfer credits into the program from a regionally accredited academic institution
- Minimum 2.5 GPA to Apply - 3.0 GPA To Graduate
- Must apply for graduation the semester prior to completing program
- Must have a Bachelors Degree from a regionally accredited academic institution.
