

Addendum to the anthology 'Music of Cumberland & Westmorland'

- Page 35: It now appears that Dorothy Greenop was not a widow prior to marrying William Irwin.

The process of stitching together a series of separate music files caused the next three mistakes. In the process of joining multiple music files information stored in one file can change some characteristics of the following file (e.g. key signature).

- Page 41: Key signature should read as D major (i.e. 2 sharps)
 - Page 79: Key signature should read as D major (i.e. 2 sharps)
 - Page 94: Some odd accidentals appear in the music on the first line. These are already covered by the key signature and are therefore superfluous.

- Page 100: In bar 7 there are consecutive 5ths between the bass and middle parts. This is incorrect within the context of this music. The last note of the middle part in bar 7 should be 'A'.
