Brighter Living Home Services: A fee based companion service providing one (1) to twenty-four (24) hour assistance to senior in their homes. Services include housekeeping, meal preparation, transportation, running errands, companionship and other services. Each person's care plan is customized based on the individual's need.

<u>Care Management:</u> Elder Care's Care Managers, act as service coordinators, advocates and advisors who help mature adults maintain independence and enjoy safe, comfortable living conditions in their home.

Caregiver Support Group: Meets weekly to offer practical information in a nurturing environment.

<u>Day Break:</u> Adult Day Health Center, open Monday through Friday, 7:30a.m - 5:30p.m. Provides social interaction, therapeutic activities, fitness, music and a nutritious lunch for adults of various levels of physical and cognitive ability, who need supervised care in a safe environment during the week.

Medical Equipment Loan: Elder Care loans medical equipment at no charge for as long as needed.

Physical Therapy: Outpatient physical therapy specializing in the physical needs of patients age 60 and older. Atmosphere, equipment and staff focused on caring for the well being of mature adults. Medicare and most major insurance is accepted.

Speech Therapy: Specializing in traditional speech therapy as well as the LSVT LOUD Program for voice, NMES therapy for dysphagia and cognitive treatment for patients who are in the initial stages of cognitive decline.

W.R. Bohon Senior Health Clinic: Features a geriatrician specializing in patients age 60 and older. This can be a primary care giver or a secondary opinion. Medicare and most major insurance is accepted.
