Adult Protective Services (APS) provides services to protect vulnerable adults. They investigate abuse and neglect of elderly, disabled and incapacitated adults.

Energy Assistance:

Liheap is a one time payment made to the client's supplier of heat, such as natural gas, propane, electric and wood. The program is available depending on funding.

ECAP is a program in which a one time payment is made to the client's source of cooling. The program is available depending on funding.

Programs a Medicare Beneficiary might qualify for:

Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) This program pays your Medicare Premiums, deductibles and coinsurance.

Specified Low-income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB) This program pays your Medicare Part B premium.

Food Stamps (EBT Card)

The Food Stamp program is meant to be a supplement to income, solely for the purchase of food items. The program is federally funded and monitored through the US Department of Agriculture.

Advantage Waiver Program

A program for individuals who meet nursing home level of care guidelines, however want to remain in their own home. This program also can provide limited Adult Daycare coverage.

Nursing Home Program

This program pays a supplement for Nursing Home care.

Breast and Cervical Cancer

This program provides complete Medicaid services to those diagnosed with these diseases. It is administered through the State DHS Office and application must be made through the local County Health Department.

Many other programs available for all ages. Contact your local Department of Human Service Office for more information and eligibility requirements.
