Certificate of Compliance

This is to certify that that all substances, preparations and articles used in the manufacture of the modcon®, compu-shield®, voice series® and intrajack® series are in compliance with the Restriction of Hazardous Substance (RoHS) following directives, without exemptions, with respect to the substances named below:

EU directive 2015/863/EU

The directive bans the use of 4 poisonous substances in electrical products from 22nd of July 2019. Chemicals, elements or substances are:

- Butylbenzylphthalat (BBP)
- Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalat (DEHP)
- Dibutylphthalat (DBP)
- Diisobutylphthalat (DIBP)

EU directive 2011/65/EU

The directive bans the use of a number of poisonous substances in electrical products from 8th of June 2011. Chemicals, elements or substances are:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs)
- Polybrominated Diphenyls (PBDEs)

The EU's RoHS directive bans from 1st of July 2008 the use of Decabromdiphenylether (DecaBDE), according to decision by the EC Court of Justice, April 1st, 2008.

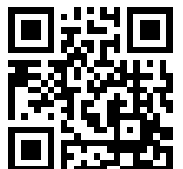
EU directive 2006/122/EG

The EU's directive bans from 27th of June 2008 the use in electrical products:

- Perfluorooctane sulfonates (PFOS)

Certificate of Compliance

The products of INELCO are in compliance with European Union Directive 1907/2006 on the Registration Evaluation Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

Based on information provided by our suppliers, INELCO designates its products as REACH compliant for orders based on or after the date of this certification.

REACH compliant means, that regarding the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidate list recently released by the European Chemicals Agency on October 28, 2008, INELCO's products do not contain more than 0.1% by weight per article of any substance on the SVHC candidate list.

We will continue to monitor the status of the candidate list as part of our on-going compliance activities, including the possible need under Article 33 of REACH to inform product recipients and consumers if an article contains more than 0.1% by weight per article of any substance that is added to the SVHC candidate list in the future.
