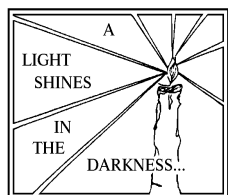

**RCIA – New Classes Forming**

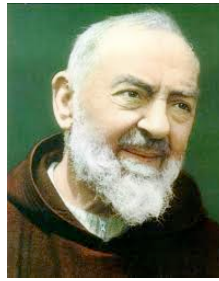
