

2018 LENTEN REGULATIONS

- 1. On GOOD FRIDAY, and ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT, Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to refrain from eating meat. On GOOD FRIDAY, all Catholics from ages 18-60 inclusive are bound to observe a sacred fast, that is, taking only one full meal during the day, and two smaller meals, which together do not equal one full meal. There is no eating between meals.
- **2**. The time for fulfilling the (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 18th to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, May 27th
