

The SDG Impact Assess Tool










The SDG Impact Assessment Tool

- Self-assessment of how activities, organizations or projects affect the SDGs by identifying positive/negative and direct/indirect impacts, or knowledge gaps.
- Learning tool about the SDGs themselves, their inter-linkages and identifying relevant sustainability perspectives of your work?
- Users include venture capital companies, innovation offices, universities, small companies, sustainability consultants, and municipalities.










Results visualization
