

# Daily confirmed COVID-19 cases per million people, Jun 9, 2020



The number of confirmed cases is lower than the number of total cases. The main reason for this is limited testing.





## Daily and total confirmed COVID-19 deaths per million, Jun 9, 2020




Limited testing and challenges in the attribution of the cause of death means that the number of confirmed deaths may not be an accurate count of the true number of deaths from COVID-19.




### Daily new confirmed COVID-19 deaths


#### International travel controls during the COVID-19 pandemic, Feb 5, 2020






#### YouGov COVID-19 behaviour changes tracker: Wearing a face mask when in public places

% of people in each country who say they are: Improving personal hygiene (e.g. washing hands frequently, using hand sanitiser).




#### COVID-19 Testing Policies, Feb 28, 2020



COVID-19 testing policies are categorized as follows:

- No testing policy.
- Only those who both (a) have symptoms and also (b) meet specific criteria (eg key workers, admitted to hospital, came into contact with a known case, returned from overseas).
- Testing of anyone showing COVID-19 symptoms.
- Open public testing (e.g "drive through" testing available to asymptomatic people).




