Rules & Procedures for Safe and Successful Virtual Programming: BGCSFV Members & Guests

Members must follow all Club rules as outlined in the BGCSFV member handbook, as well as any additional technology usage rules, Esports member handbook, and virtual programming rules. Staff and volunteers are expected to enforce these rules at all times; if applicable disciplinary procedures will be enforced.

Members and guests may not use any language that is considered to be profane, offensive, discriminatory, or disrespectful. This includes language that is spoken or typed/written.

Members and guests may not engage in behavior that is considered to be aggressive or bullying.

Be respectful of others during live programs, and follow directions given by staff.

Be prepared before the session starts. If the directions or introductions state that you need supplies, make sure you have everything before the activity starts.

Let staff know if you don't understand directions or if you are having technical trouble so they can try to help you.

Members and guests must have parent/guardian permission before they participate in Virtual Club programs and activities. Only current BGCSFV members that have a signed parental consent form may participate in live-stream sessions (e.g., Zoom).

Members and guests can be disciplined for violating BGCSFV member handbook, technology usage, and virtual programming rules. Discipline is up to the discretion of each Area Director and/or the Program Monitor, and can include a verbal or written warning, removal from the activity/session, suspension from Club activities (virtual and/or traditional in-person), or expulsion from BGCSFV.
