

## PAPER

- Cardboard  
(must be broken down and placed in the cart)
- Boxboard  
(e.g. shoe boxes, cereal boxes)
- Newspaper
- Magazines, catalogs & glossy paper
- Paper bags
- Paper packaging
- Egg cartons
- Milk, juice & aseptic (foil-lined) cartons\*
- Junk mail
- Phone books & soft-cover books
- Envelopes  
(labels or windows OK)
- Office paper (all colors)
- Shredded paper in clear bags

**PLEASE NO** tissues, towels, paper with plastic coatings (such as photographs or label backing), food-soiled paper, waxed paper, foil-lined paper, hardcover books, binders, or Tyvek (non-tearing) envelopes.

## GLASS

- Bottles & jars
  - All colors, lids removed
  - Rinsed & empty (labels okay)

**PLEASE NO** window glass, mirrors, crystal, Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs, or fluorescent lamps/tubes.

## METAL

- Aluminum cans
- Tin & steel cans
- Clean aluminum pans & foil\*
- Empty aerosol cans
- Scrap metal\* (up to 36")
- Pots, pans & utensils\*
- Loose lids from jars

**PLEASE NO** electronic or computer equipment.

## PLASTIC

- Bottles & jugs
  - All numbers & colors
  - Rinsed & empty, leave caps on
- All rigid non-bottle plastics, such as:\*
  - Tubs & containers (e.g. yogurt, margarine)
  - Buckets, pails & crates
  - Toys (e.g. plastic tricycles)
  - Clamshell trays & deli containers
  - Plant pots (no ceramics)
  - Laundry baskets

**PLEASE NO** Styrofoam, plastic bags or plastic film/wrap (recycle bags at supermarkets & large retailers).

Upper Valley Disposal and Recycling accepts plastic grocery bags.

\*Some of these items may not be accepted up-valley or in American Canyon – check with service provider.

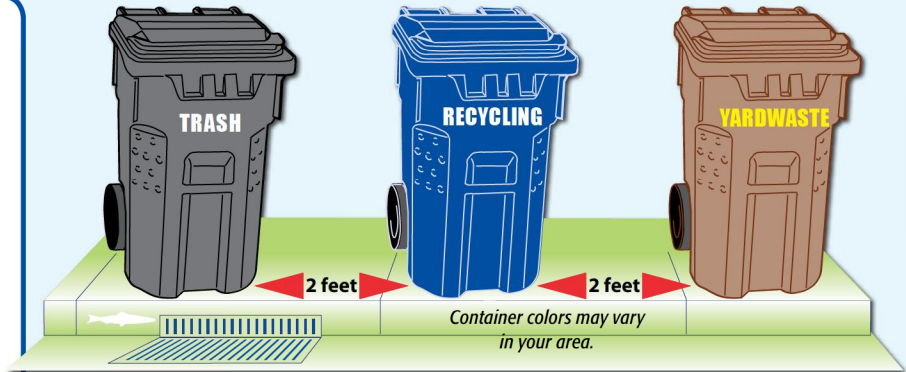
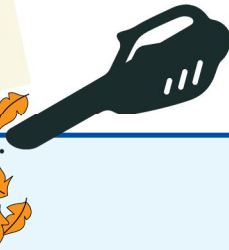
## YARDWASTE



Yardwaste consists of grass clippings, leaves, brush, garden prunings, or fruits and vegetables from your yard and branches six inches in diameter or smaller.

**Please no rocks, dirt, animal waste or painted wood.**

Help create valuable compost and protect local waterways by placing leaves in your compost bin, instead of blowing or raking them into the street or storm drain.



### IMPORTANT

**All items must be placed in the cart. When your cart is full, set it out by 6am\* on your service day, at least 2 feet away from other carts and 4-6 feet from other objects, lid opening facing the curb.**

\*Up-valley residents and businesses should set out trash, recyclables and greenwaste the night before collection day.

**NO HAZARDOUS WASTE** such as automotive fluids, pesticides and fertilizers, paint products, cleaners, batteries, etc. For safe and legal disposal of hazardous waste, see page 14.
