## Palm Sunday of The Passion of The Lord 28th March

3 Masses will be celebrated as usual, the 6 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday and on Sunday at 10am and 12 Noon. The procession will not take place this year. The palm branches will be blessed at the beginning and will be distributed to you as you leave the church after Mass.



# Maundy Thursday 1st April

Mass of the Last Supper will take place at **8pm** as usual but sadly the Washing of the Feet **is not allowed** and there is **no procession** of the Blessed Sacrament from the altar to the Hal Chapel this year. The Blessed Sacrament is to be kept in the tabernacle on the altar and the watching of the Blessed Sacrament will be for a **half hour** at the end of Mass. The church will close at **9.30pm** for reasons of safety.



### Good Friday 2nd April

The celebration of the Passion of the Lord is at **3pm** as usual. The veneration of the Holy Cross will take place as normal but the congregation will not be invited to kiss the cross for health and safety reasons. The congregation will stay in their seats, kneeling silently in prayer, after which there will be Holy Communion.
