Mitch Cornish reported that there are various water breaks throughout the city. The one on Riverside Place has been located and is being repaired. Crews are still chasing the leak around Maple and Collier Streets and Stearn & Stearn Textiles are repairing their leak. Mitch said that the salt truck and plows are ready for the predicted storm this weekend. He also reminded the public that throwing or dumping snow into a city street is illegal.

Mayor Buckley commended Brian Butler on the work he did while repairing a sewer problem at the Moose Club. Butler did a nice job resurfacing Seneca St. when the repairs were finished.

Lenny Fucci reported that they are still waiting for DOH approval on the Water Treatment project plans. Labellas are still aiming to go to bid January 24.
