Lenny, WTP – There are two scheduled plant shutdowns scheduled on June 24 and on July 9. They will be monitoring pressures throughout the city and they will be opening hydrants to relieve pressure. The system will probably get stirred up, so they will schedule a boil water advisory system wide. This will be the first time the tank has been taken offline.

Rich, WPCP – The plant is working very well. It is operating at peak efficiency. The have reapplied for the sludge disposal permit for 5 more years. All equipment for disposal was purchased in 1985, we should think about putting some money into new hardware in the future.

Mitch, DPW – The first round of paving is done. Maintenance is starting, including mowing and summer workers. The bridge projects are working steady. The WTP project is moving along and the tank should be back online within 3 weeks. Round of two of paving should take place at the end of August. The pool, while it isn't being used this year, will have to be emptied and filled a couple times to maintain it and keep it up and running.
