Minutes of regular meeting Thursday November 10, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by chair Steve Keene

Minutes of meetings 10/13/2016 and 10/25/2016 read and approved.

New Business:

1) Elections:

Since the last regular meeting, June Bergren resigned from the council. Her position is up for election, to fill a term from January 2017 through December 2022. Also up for election is the position previously held by Laura Portolese-Diaz, as she resigned in May 2016 due to moving out of the district. She had been appointed to fill out the term previously held by Kathy Springer, running from January 2011 through December 2016.

Doug Clarke and Tricia Ortiz are currently filling terms running from January 2013 through December 2018. Cheryl Parsley, Leticia Vizcaino and Steve Keene are currently filing terms running from January 2015 through December 2020.

Stan Winters has submitted application for one of the positions; since June's resignation came after the last regular meeting it was not possible for applicants to submit timely applications prior to this election. Therefore write-ins will be accepted; two people have expressed interest: Devera Sharp and Lacey Price.

Election was held; the two candidates with greatest votes are Stan Winters and Lacey Price. Their terms will begin with the January 2016 meeting.

Stan Winters is willing to fill the vacant position for November and December 2016, prior to starting his elected term in January 2017.

2) Treasurer Vacancy:

Since June Bergren has resigned as of October 2016 and previously served as treasurer, that position needs to be filled with an interim prior to election of officers to be held in January 2017. Cheryl Parsley is willing to serve in that capacity, and was elected unanimously. Patricia Ortiz, secretary, agreed to be second signatory on the checking account with Cashmere Valley Bank.

3) Santa Breakfast:

Pancake breakfast will be held Saturday December 10, 2016 from 8:30 to 10:30 at Peshastin Memorial Hall.

Cheryl Parsley has contacted Chelan-Douglas Health Department for the food handler's permit. Jill Clevenger will bring coffee from Starbuck's, and small apples. Glenda Hargrove will help with cooking. Gene Sherwood will serve as Santa; Jim Hargrove as backup if needed. Cheryl has contacted Anne Conrad at Cascade High School to request the choir to perform.

Patricia Ortiz will contact the fire department to bring Santa.  
Edie Daniels and Kathy Springer will sell tickets at the door.  
Stan Winters will provide music for the time the choir is not singing.  
Steve Keene will contact face painters.  
Each council member will bring a decorated gingerbread house for the children's drawing.  
Cost for tickets: \$6 for 12 and over; \$3 for 6 to 11; under 6 free  
Stan and Vania Winters will provide stockings or equivalent for 75, with stuffing items that will be assembled at the next meeting.  
Patricia Ortiz will create notices to be posted in the library, Dan's Food Market, Peshastin Market, post office; notice will be placed in the Cashmere and Leavenworth newspapers.

The next meeting will be held at 6 pm on Thursday, December 8, 2016, to include decorating the hall and preparation for Santa breakfast.
