Minutes of regular meeting 02-09-2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm by chair Steve Keene

Minutes of the meeting 01-12-2017 were read and approved

Treasurer's report: Bank balance of \$1306.67

2 checks are outstanding to the Peshastin Fire Department for Santa Breakfast and June 2016 Kids and Pets Parade

We have sent \$1200 deposit to Rusty Gibbs for the Peshastin sign refurbishment

Steve reported on the proposed PUD upgrade to the Peshastin Sewer system, planned to decrease phosphorus entering the Wenatchee River. The project is second place on the list for a Department of Ecology loan for 2.9 million dollars in 2018. The 2016 estimate for the project was 7.5 million. It is uncertain at this time whether the project will proceed as planned.

Lacey reports that the sale of the Peshastin Mill property, riverfront portion has closed.

Steve reports that the Peshastin community website update is in process.

Stan asked about past history of the Community Council participating in community service. He recently became aware of another community launching a project to provide computers for students or families of limited resources in a school district, and would like to pursue information about a similar project for our community. He will obtain more detailed information and report to the council. Discussion was held about goals of the Community Council, and long range planning regarding future projects. Lacey offered to facilitate a planning workshop for the council to review short and long term goals and projects, date to be determined.
