Minutes of regular meeting 03-09-2017  
Peshastin Memorial Hall

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by chair Steve Keene

Minutes of meeting 02-09-2017 were read and approved as corrected

Treasurer's report: Bank balance of \$1306.67

Two checks remain outstanding to Peshastin Fire Department. Doug will make inquiry about them being cashed.

#### Old Business

A. Mill Site: Lacey reports the deeding of the riverfront portion to the State Fish and Wildlife has been completed. She will inquire about the upland portion and report back.

B. Peshastin web site is still in process; Steve requests more updated pictures for the site

C. The bid received from Gibbs Signs was reviewed. Part of the bid includes haul off and disposal of the old sign. There was agreement we want to preserve the old sign for historical interest in the Memorial Hall. Rusty Gibbs has suggested consideration of 3-D letters for the new sign; after discussion it was agreed to use standard lettering, not 3-D. It is also unclear if there is a charge for cutting off the old sign. We will contact Rusty with this information.

D. Stan presented information about the reduced cost internet service available for low income families through Charter. Since LocalTel provides fiber connection in this area, he will contact them to see if similar service may be available.

#### New Business

A. Steve has recently attended meetings at the Chelan County PUD: one regarding the Long Range Facilities planning, with a 50 year plan; one regarding the three sites under consideration for the new Leavenworth substation; and one regarding the Upper Valley Water and Wastewater Regionalization Study.

B. Steve reports that the Tour de Bloom, a Wenatchee velo event with bikers riding from Wenatchee to Leavenworth and back, is scheduled for May 5-7. At this time there is a proposal for the tour route to go up and down the North Road, avoiding Highway 2 from Peshastin to Leavenworth. Doug voiced concern about the disruption to orchardists along the North Road. There will be a meeting March 15 at the Leavenworth Fire Hall to take public comment regarding the proposed changes.

C. Doug and Tricia shared some historical perspective of the Peshastin community.

The next meeting will be held April 13, 2017.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:42 pm.
