

## Minutes of regular meeting of Peshastin Community Council May 11, 2017

Peshastin Memorial Hall

Members present: chair, Steve Keene; Lacey Price; Doug Clarke; Tricia Ortiz

Members absent, excused: Cheryl Parsley, Leticia Vizcaino; Stan Winters

Community members present: Sharon Waters, Leavenworth; Kirk Laird, Peshastin

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes of the meeting April 13, 2017 read and approved by unanimous voice vote.

Treasurer's report: bank balance unchanged, \$1306.67. Two checks still outstanding from June 2016 and December 2016, both to Peshastin Fire Department.

Old business:

- 1) No update on Peshastin sign. Tricia will check with Rusty Gibbs for progress report.
- 2) Pet parade, June 3, 2017. Maile Woodin is head organizer, no report available. Lacey will contact her about the flyer for publicity, and make sure band has been contacted. Tricia will buy new ribbons for participants. Cheryl will buy popsicles for the event. Parade begins at 10 a.m. at the Memorial Hall, with assembly starting at 9:30.

New Business:

- 1) Peshastin Water District report from Steve: the new office for the water district will be located at the PUD office on Chumstick Highway in Leavenworth, behind the fire hall. The Timberline water system has been retested and is all clear of contaminants. The source of the contamination was confined to one location, which has been corrected. Two users of Timberline water have now voiced interest in meter placement. The entire system has until December 31, 2017 to become compliant with individual user meter placement to avoid shut off of Peshastin water.
- 2) Tour de Bloom bicycle event was completed without apparent difficulties.
- 3) The new updated Peshastin website is nearing completion. Steve is constructing the site, and reports that a one time fee of \$299 will purchase lifetime hosting of the site. The Peshastin Cemetery District and the Peshastin Water District are interested in splitting the fee 3 ways with the Community Council. Motion by Lacey Price, second by Patricia Ortiz, to spend \$100 for this fee. Unanimous voice vote to approve. The changeover to the new site is anticipated to occur in the next few days.
- 4) Discussion was held in response to questions from Sharon Waters about the structure and function of the Council. Discussion held regarding future planning for the Peshastin Urban Growth Area, specifically in regard to non-resident nightly rentals within the UGA. Council members agreed that a review of this issue in the near future is appropriate.

5) Lacey reported that the Complete The Loop Coalition in conjunction with Washington Fish and Wildlife are starting the process of marking the trail through the old Peshastin mill site.

The next meeting will be held Thursday June 8 at the Peshastin Memorial Hall, at 7 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:36 p.m.
