

Job Title: Guestspeaker/Trainer

## Objectives of the Job:

- 1. To advise/inform participants on selected topics
- 2. To enhance participants' awareness of resources within the local community

## Job Activities:

- Work with coordinator to co-plan the presentation to ensure it meets the course needs and goals
- 2. To present topics as discussed with the program coordinator
- 3. To answer relevant questions as individuals or within a panel-based discussion
- 4. At the request of participants, provide referrals to resources.

## Performance Requirements:

- 1. Volunteers must possess experience and/or expertise in their field
- 2. All presentations are made in order to support and inform women or girls; not for the purpose of marketing a product or service
- 3. Speakers will work with the program coordinator to co-plan the session to ensure it meets the needs of the program and participants
- 4. Speakers may be well-known in the local community
- 5. All speakers need to have a warm and inviting approach to their presentation providing relevant and interesting information

## Parameters of Job:

- 1. Women in Business/Business of Life: one or two session commitment delivered either during the day or in the evening twice a year as part of the ten week program.
- 2. Enterprising Women: one off session commitment delivered throughout the year during the day or in the evening.
- 3. Knowing Her Mind module presenter: one session commitment to speak on mental well-being and provide lived experience perspective for this module in both the Women in Business and Business of Life programs twice a year.
- 4. Youth Programs: one session commitment and must have an up to date criminal record name check. Example topics include: substance use/abuse, yoga, martial arts, gender identity.
