Vehicle processing

- If the vehicle is not redeemed within 120 hours from the time it was impounded it will be declared an abandoned vehicle and will be processed as such and sold at auction to the highest bidder. RCW 46.55
- For suspended driver license impounds, the vehicle is being held at the direction of law enforcement for _____ days.
- The towing firm (within 5 days of the impound) is requiring payment of a security deposit in an amount up to one-half of the applicable storage rate for the above hold period.

If the security deposit is not paid, the vehicle will be processed as abandoned and sold at auction. The registered owner will be ineligible to purchase the vehicle. The security deposit may be paid up to 24 hours before the auction.

If the driver was also the registered owner of the vehicle they must provide proof from the impounding agency or court of satisfaction of any penalties, fines, or forfeitures, before the vehicle can be redeemed.

- Upon payment related to the removal, towing, and storage, an impounded vehicle may be redeemed by: the legal owner, the registered owner, the vehicle's insurer, someone authorized in writing by the registered owner, a person determined and verified by the towing firm to have permission of the registered owner, or someone who has purchased the vehicle from the registered owner who produces proof of ownership or written authorization and signs a receipt.
- The vehicle shall be released upon the presentation of: cash, a major bank credit card (the law provides penalties for stopping payment on credit card charges or using invalid credit cards), or a personal check drawn on an in-state bank if accompanied by two pieces of valid I.D., one of which may be required to have a photograph (the law provides penalties for stopping payment on a check or issuing a check with non-sufficient funds).
- You have the right to request a hearing in district/municipal court to contest the validity of the impound or the towing and storage fees. Your hearing request must be received by the court within 10 days of the date that you seek to redeem the vehicle and not less than 5 days before the auction. There is a filing fee and the registered tow truck operator will provide you with a hearing request form when you seek to redeem the vehicle.
