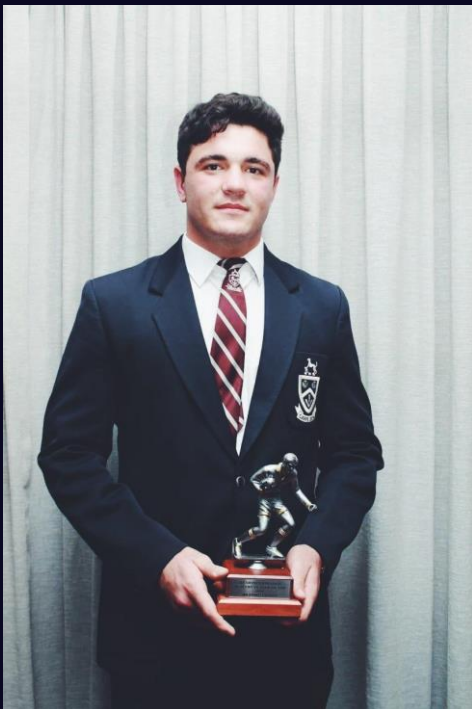

Massimo Fierro is an enigma. There are very few players in South Africa that can replicate his skill set. His strength and ball carrying, his hard as nails defence and exceptional rugby IQ paired with his world class ball stealing ability sets him apart from every other schoolboy in the country. However, his dedication to the sport, his professional approach and eager determination to improve is reminiscent of players who has left a big mark on the world of rugby.

Massimo spent his entire High School career at Kearsney College, after being rewarded with a scholarship in 2016. In his first three years he started every single game, never once getting injured. In 2018 the Kearsney College first XV coaches awarded Massimo's hard work by giving him his debut as a 15 year old. It was during these matches and training sessions Massimo utilized his support play, rugby IQ and ball stealing ability to full effect.

His exposure to first team rugby at a young age proved helpful in his following years at Kearsney, earning Sharks Craven week honours in 2019. Massimo was also voted Most valuable player for his school's first XV team. Massimo's work rate and pace was also utilized by the 7's coaches where he performed exceptionally well – being awarded Sharks 7's colours and was appointed as Vice-Captain.

In 2020 Massimo was elected as first team captain and played in all the games before Covid-19 cut the season short. One can only imagine what he could have achieved if given the chance.

Massimo is eligible to play in South Africa, the UK and Italy, due to his ancestry. His professionalism, teamwork, leadership and his pursuit of success will make him an asset to any team.
