

Vintage Creek HOA Pool Rules

THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. This is a private pool for the exclusive use of residents and their guest(s). Residents and guests use these facilities and swim at their own risk. The Association and its agents are not responsible and will be harmless for accidents or injuries to any homeowner, homeowner(s) children, and/or their guest(s). The Association is not responsible for personal property at the pool. Please respect the rights of your neighbors while enjoying our community's pool.

- This area is for members and their non-resident guests only. Maximum of four (4) guests per household is allowed. All guests must be accompanied by an adult household member(s) and the homeowner shall be responsible for any damages and/or actions of their guest(s).
- The pool opens daily at 8:00 AM and closes promptly at 9:00 PM.
- Children under the age of 14 MUST be accompanied by an adult homeowner. All children are the responsibility of their parent(s) or guardian who must be present with children in the pool area at all times.
- NO PETS OR ANIMALS allowed in the pool area by order of the Health Department.
- No glass containers allowed in the pool area by order of the Health Department.
- Keep the gate closed AT ALL TIMES.
- NO SMOKING PERMITTED in or around the enclosed pool area.
- Please dispose of all waste, trash, food, and swimmer diapers in the appropriate containers provided and clean up the table(s) after use.
- Appropriate swimming attire required; no cut-offs.
- Infants are REQUIRED to wear SWIMMER DIAPERS in the pool at all times.
- No diving, running, boisterous, or disruptive behavior; No excessive noise levels, abusive language, or abuse of pool property.
- NO skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, or other vehicles allowed in the pool area.
- NO radio use is permitted without headphones.
- Flotation devices/toys are permitted at the discretion of each Homeowner as long as it does not interfere with other swimmers. All toys are to be removed from pool area upon leaving.
- No balloons are allowed. Any damage or cost incurred by the association from damages or negligence will be billed to the homeowner and collectible as an assessment plus the homeowner may be suspended from the pool.
- The pool gate and the door to the restrooms should be closed at all times.
- Pool furniture may not be removed from the deck area. Please do not put pool furniture in the pool.
- Please lower umbrella(s) upon leaving pool.
- Lock the gate upon exiting the pool area.
- Please help us keep the pool open by following the above pool rules. If the health department closes the pool for any reason, we are not able to open it without their re-inspection.
