

Whidbey Equestrian Center 2018 Series Championships Open, Adult Amateur, Jr/Yr Divisions

Held during the August 25, 2018 "Summer's End" Dressage Show

2018 Qualifying Season is **May 5th – August 12th** (Aug 24th if planning to use last chance score)

Eligibility: To be eligible a horse/rider combination needs to accumulate

- **Four** minimum scores using **any test** of the same level (*three* minimum scores for freestyle).
- Scores must be from **Four** different WEC dressage shows, four different judges, from the qualifying season.
For Freestyles, scores from three different judges from three different shows.
- Nomination form **form A** to declare by **July 10, 2018**. *After July 10 through August 12, Form B shall be used. Form B must be submitted close of business on August 12.* Class fee must be included with form.
- To use the Last Chance Score from Aug 24th, use Form B. Form B cannot be used on Aug 24 to add in to the entirety of the Championship series. Class fee must be included with form.
- WEC Schooling shows are not qualifying shows.

The horse/rider combination may compete in only **one** Championship division (Open, AA, Jr/Yr)

- For Open: Riders must be declared as "open" on their USDF/USEF memberships
- For AA: Adult Amateur must be declared on their USDF/USEF memberships
- For Jr/Yr: This division is for rider's declared as Jr/Yr on their USDF/USEF memberships
- In accordance to USDF Championship rules, the horse/rider combination may compete at the same level and be eligible for WEC finals if they won last year (USEF DR 127.5).

Scoring: Series Placement for USEF-FEI and Freestyle will be determined as follows:

50% of the total of average of the BEST of **four** scores (freestyle best of three scores)

50% of the total score ridden from the designated Summer's End Saturday Class.

Combined Total = percentage for class placement.

Classes: All Championship classes will be run concurrently with the WEC Summer's End Dressage Show.

- You must enter the corresponding class Saturday at the Summer's End show. These classes are:

206 - USEF Training Level – Test 3	221 - FEI Intermediate I
209 - USEF First Level – Test 3	222 – FEI Grand Prix
212 - USEF Second Level – Test 3	224 – FEI Intermediate II
215 - USEF Third Level – Test 3	227 – FEI Freestyle (I-1/GP)
218 - USEF Fourth Level – Test 3	229 – USDF Freestyle (1 st – 4th)
220 - FEI Prix St Georges	
- WEC Classes will be run under USEF Rules, therefore, whips are allowed at all levels and tests may be read.

Championship Awards: Last Year for "Grandma Quilt".

- USEF – FEI (except Freestyle): By rider division. Championship Neck Ribbons to Grand and Reserve, Coolers/Quarter sheets to Grand. Professional photo for class champion and reserve Champion Awards. Series Final ribbons to five places in each level.
- FREESTYLE AWARDS by division (singular placement not by level): USDF: Neck ribbons 1-3, FEI: Neck ribbons all levels.
- "Grandma" Quilt – eligibility rule applies. Award to high point percentage of the championship class for each rider division.

Award Presentation:

- Rider & Horse must be dressed, tacked and present to receive awards and photo.
- Award schedule times will be posted in the show program. Awards ceremony Saturday late afternoon.
- Championship classes will be awarded percentage and division. Freestyle award not divided by test level.

- 2016 and 2017 Winners are eligible to compete at the same level in 2018 per USDF Championship Rule
- Nomination fee must be on separate check from show entry fee.
- No nomination fee refunds if not enough Qualifying scores for the WEC Championship.
- Form can be submitted any time until July 10. Entry fee scaled by show date.
