#### After Hours Childcare/Late Fees

Effective October 17<sup>th</sup>, we will begin to enforce our late fees policy. As many of you know, WACA is opened from 6:30AM to 6:00PM each day. We have extended our school hours to provide a convenience and consistent care to your child. In order to do this, we hire additional staff to be present each day. When parents arrive after 6:00PM, we have to continue paying personnel after hours. If you will pick up your child late, we ask that you call the office to notify us that you will need after hours childcare. For this convenience, there will be a \$5 charge at 6:01PM and \$1 for every minute after. We will provide you an invoice at the end of the week to let you know the cost or you can pay upon pickup or the following day. Thank you, in advance, for honoring our "after hours childcare" policy.

Thanks to each of you who have already submitted your necessary paperwork! Starting next week, we will begin calling home with daily reminders about missing paperwork. If you haven't done so already, please submit your enrollment and food forms today. The food forms will help us secure a food grant to hopefully cover all food expenses. To help your child receive the highest reimbursement, we are asking you to complete the food enrollment & income eligibility documents as well.
