

Advanced dementia care skills

The **aim** of this course will provide staff who have already undertaken the dementia awareness course or who influence care practice with more in-depth knowledge of dementia and explore key concepts relating to the care of people with dementia. At the start of the course participants will review existing knowledge of dementia and person-centred care work.

- Describe the concepts of person-centred care, including well-being and ill-being, personal enhancers and personal detractors, occupation and enablement.
- Use well-being and ill-being profiles and review care planning.
- Identify and practice effective communication skills for working with people with dementia.
- Understand behaviour and manage behaviour that challenges.
