

Bee Inspired leadership in dementia care (in partnership with Jackie Pool)

This is a three-day programme for senior staff and managers. The first two days provide an opportunity to:

- Explore the role of a leader in dementia care settings.
- Exchange ideas of how to energise the dementia care setting.
- Develop person-centred leadership skills.
- Discuss resources for developing the dementia care workforce knowledge and skills.
- Become familiar with the QCF programmes and resources for supporting a healing environment.
- Become familiar with the Jackie Pool Bee Inspired Dementia Care Toolbox.
- Prepare to implement the Jackie Pool Bee Inspired Dementia Care Toolbox in the dementia care setting.

Following the first two consecutive days there will be a three-month workplace activity to implement learning and the Bee Inspired Dementia Care Tools. All participants will be required to complete a reflective journal and attend day three.

Day three is a reflective workshop providing an opportunity for participants to discuss the experience of implementing the Jackie Pool Bee Inspired Dementia Care Tools. Participants will also:

- Share ideas for supporting implementation of care staff development.
- Share outcomes.
- Use a problem solving approach to address any difficulties.
- Determine how they will sustain their dementia care service development.
