

Working effectively as part of a team to provide person-centred care

- Identify some of the barriers to effective teamwork and explain how these may be overcome.
- Demonstrate the need for a balance between person-centred and task oriented approaches to providing person-centred dementia care.
- Explain how teamwork can promote 'enabling approaches' to delivering services to older people and people with dementia.
