- Residents scaling out after 3 will be charged a \$25 fee per every 15 minutes, or part of, following 3:00
- Residents not scaling out will be assessed a \$25 fee

#### **EVENING HOURS:** Wednesday 4-7 PM

- Recycling available for non-stickered residents
- Current sticker required for household trash
- C&D and Oversized MSW section CLOSED

#### **CLOSED:**

• July 4, Labor, Christmas, New Year & Memorial Day

#### **USAGE:**

- Residency required (Barkhamsted, New Hartford, or Winsted)
- All items brought into the transfer station MUST be from households within the District

#### **PERMIT STICKER:**

- Purchased at gatehouse during regular "day" hours
- DMV registration required
- Additional proof of residency required if not on registration
- Vehicles MUST be on site for sticker placement
- Affixed to the lower driver's side windshield
- NO STICKER swapping

## **CASH AND CHECKS ONLY**

#### STICKER FEES

• Annual\* \$ 85 (July 1- June 30) • First ½ Year\* \$ 50 (July 1- December 31) Second ½ Year\* \$ 50 (January 1- June 30) • Contractor/Landlord\* \$160 (July 1- June 30)

• Additional Stickers – same household \$5 with proof

#### **DAY PASS**

- RESIDENT USE, ONE DAY ONLY
- \$15\* at the gatehouse (regular hours daily)
- \*Additional fees for C&D, oversized MSW and unseparated loads. (Please separate recyclables to save dollars and protect our earth.) RRDD1 reserves the right to limit quantity and reject loads. When purchasing a sticker / day pass – you agree to abide by the rules of the facility.

#### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT RRDD1:**

- CHEMICALS of any nature are NOT ACCEPTED EVER! Illegal dumping of chemicals is a very serious matter. You, employees of RRDD1 and/ or staff at other transfer stations can get seriously injured due to YOUR mistake! Cameras have been installed! You will be held responsible! DON'T DO IT!
- Petroleum products other than used engine oil.
- Tires ON RIM from large truck and farm machinery.
- Waste from outside the District: Residents/Contractors are reminded that any item inbound at RRDD1 MUST come from Barkhamsted, New Hartford or Winsted/ Winchester. Failure to comply may result in loss of dumping privileges.
- Motor vehicles, RV's, campers & boats.
- Household Hazardous Waste (see HHW page)
- RRDD1 no longer accepts tree stumps larger than a 6" diameter tree base.

#### **SPECIAL ITEMS ACCEPTED:**

- Oil tanks- ONLY if empty and dry, MUST be cut open either in half or a large hole in the bottom
- Fluorescent Bulbs accepted, max 6/wk., residential only. Contractors MUST contact their vendor for proper disposal.
- Mattress / Box: Accepted FREE of charge, UNLESS the item is soggy (dripping wet), heavily soiled, broken frame, damaged. (\$20 Fee assessed for these cases as the vendor will not accept them from RRDD1.)
