

MEDIORCE BUSINESS ANALYST

Communicating Risks

Thinks they have identified a risk, but aren't sure so they wait to see what happens.

Problem Solver

Did not realize there was a problem and just wrote down what the stakeholders said.

Facilitation

Primarily listens to the discussion and does not ask questions.

GOOD BUSINESS ANALYST

Communicating Risks

Identified a risk and sent an email to the Project Manager about it.

Problem Solver

Realized there was a problem, documented the problem but unsure of how to solve it.

Facilitation

Participates in the discussion. Asks pointed questions based on the topic being discussed.

GREAT BUSINESS ANALYST

Communicating Risks

Identified risk, alerted project team, provided suggestions to eliminate the risk, followed up.


Problem Solver

Realized there was a problem, documented the problem, provided at least one possible solution to the problem.

Facilitation

Actively leads the discussion and asks questions which will help ensure the goal of the discussion is met.

- ☐ Have a strong sense of project management


Common Skills of a Successful Business Analyst
