What is a domain Name

What is a domain name?

A domain name is an identification string that defines a realm of administrative autonomy, authority or control within the Internet. Domain names are used in various networking contexts and for application-specific naming and addressing purposes.

In real terms, it's the web address people type in to drive them to your website.

Example: www.trainingformovers.com

How to choose a domain name

A domain name is very important. It tells search engines and your customers' what type of business you are.

Your domain name should include the word "movers" or "moving"

Example: www.micksmovers.com or www.seattleofficemoving.com

Make sure you register the domain name with a .com

DO NOT USE .org or .net or anything else as it looks unprofessional.

How to register a domain name

Step 1: Search availability of domain name

Go to <u>www.godaddy.com</u> and select a domain name that closely matches your business name.

Step 2: Register domain name

You can use Godaddy or Cheapdomains.com to buy the domain name. You will need to pay a fee of between \$10 and \$30 depending on the name.

Choosing a website platform

Website builders are a perfect solution for you to start a website without hiring a developer.

However, finding the best website builder can be tricky for newbies.

There are three ways you can build a website.

- 1. Hardcode a site: You need a developer and it can cost \$10k or more
- 2. Use Wordpress: You can choose templates but it's expensive if you don't know what you are doing.
- 3. Use an easy builder: Godaddy, Wix, Duda.co are great low cost alternatives.

The website builder I use

I use Duda. Duda.co is easy to setup and has pre-built templates for movers.

Customizing your template

When you customize a template you are simply changing all the parts of the template to make it specific to your business.

You will need to add a logo, company name, choose colors, add pictures and contact details.

You also need a site plan of all the different pages on your website.
