SUPERBOWL UPDATE AND 2020 GOALS

Greetings!

I hope everyone had a great start to the year. January is always a busy time for me what with the lead up to the Superbowl Outreach. It was an edifying time for us. Near 90 evangelists hitting the streets of Miami, a bustling place on any normal day but all the more with the events surrounding the game. As a team leader it was my responsibility to make sure the 10 of us accomplished what we came to do, which was to tell as many people as we could of the good news of what Christ came to do, using our preaching, our conversations and our tracts. Thankfully I was blessed with a strong team of seasoned evangelists who were eager to sow the seed of the Gospel. There are two people I want to tell you about. The first one was Thomas, a young homeless man who saw our signs and heard our preaching and wanted to ask us a few questions. Zoe White, a team member, and I were able to plead with him for a good while to trust in Christ. Towards the end of our conversations we offered to pray for him and he agreed. Please pray that God would grant him repentance and faith. Also pray that he would find his way off the streets. Also please pray for James, another homeless man who had hit rock bottom. He drew near due to the sound of our preaching. We were able to get him some food and point him to a homeless shelter where he could get sober and cleaned up. Please pray that James was able to find his way there and that Christ begins and completes a good work in him. On Sunday we ministered outside Hard Rock Stadium. I wasn't sure what to expect but there ended up

being countless thousands of people. There a number of competing groups out there proselytizing for their cause. It was quite a collision for worldviews. Muslims, Jehovah's Witnesses, Black Hebrew Israelites, and Westboro Baptists to name a few. In spite of all the noise, we were able to touch many thousands of people in some way with the Gospel message. Please pray that God would give increase to the planting and watering we were able to do.

Now that the Superbowl Outreach is past I'm intending to spend the next 60 to 90 days raising support in the short term in the amount of six months of expenses saved up. At which point I plan on resigning from my job and going into full-time support raising to reach our monthly support goals and relocate to Utah. I want to give a huge thank you to my ministry partners. Your ongoing support has gotten us to this point where we are, Lord willing, soon to take this major step forward towards our goal of full-time evangelism ministry in Utah. Also I am intending to make a trip into Utah the week of April 20th for the purpose of evangelism and following up with our contacts there.
