- 2. HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRESS REPORT**—Eric Falk with Moreton Co and Rob Henderson with Cobecon presented the 2016 Quarterly Expense Report. As of March 30, 2016 \$423,951.58 has been spent on claims and administration. The Aggregate Overview Cumulative Amount is at 41.88%. Rob stated that anything under 80% is good. Employees have paid 13.56%.


According to Rob, this is a good health plan and would be Gold Status. He and Eric recommended that we look at our dental plan again. We could be getting deeper discounts by switching to a different dental plan network. The Commissioners agreed that this should be changed for the next year. Employees will be notified before the change and at the open enrollment. Local dentists will again be approached to participate in the plan.



The Stop-Loss insurance will go out for bid again. Its renewal is 10/1. It was recommended that we go from a 12/15 contract to a 12/18 contract.
