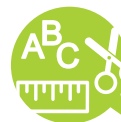

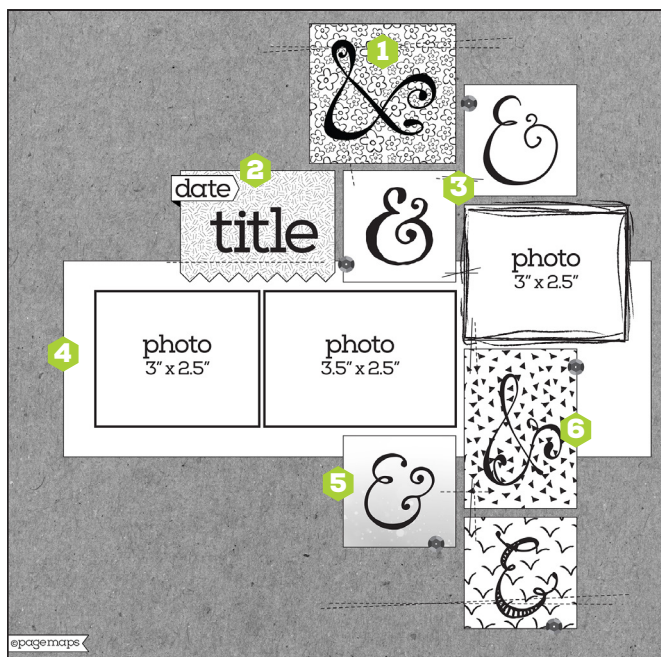

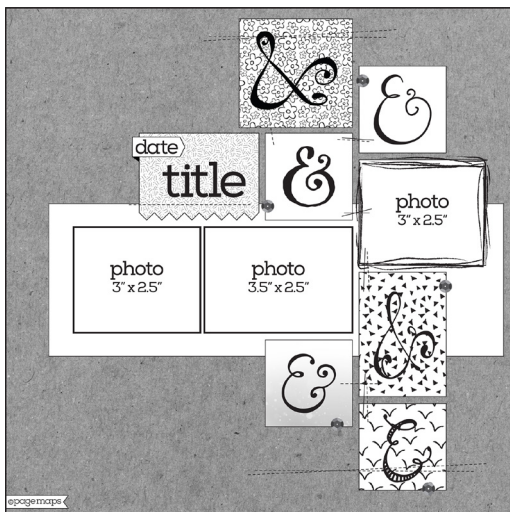
layout instructions

- 1 Use the 12x12 You Rock "In Line" patterned paper for your base layout.
- 2 Trim a 4.75"x10.5 piece of white cardstock. adhere to the base paper 2" in from the right edge and flush with the top edge.
- 3 Using black spray mist, spatter ink along the top right and bottom left corners of the page.
- 4 Adhere a 1.75"x2.25" photo to the white cardstock, .5" down from the top edge and 6" in from the left edge of the base.
- 5 Adhere a 3"x3.75" photo below the first photo, aligned on their left edges and leaving a 1/8" gap between both photos.
- 6 Adhere a 2.5"x3.25" photo below the second photo, aligned on their right edges and leaving a 1/8" gap between both photos.
- 7 Using black thread, machine or hand-stitch around each photo two times as shown. Alternatively, you can draw faux stitching lines with a journaling pen.

- 8 Open the Week 1 PMU electronic die cutting file. Die cut the ampersand designs from a variety of patterned papers. Back each die cut with a contrasting piece of patterned paper or cardstock.
- 9 Machine or hand-stitch around each ampersand die cut with contrasting thread. Alternatively, you can draw faux stitching lines with a journaling pen. Apply dimensional adhesive to the back of each die cut.
- 10 Referring to the photo, arrange the six assembled die cuts on the left and right sides of the photos as shown. When you are happy with the arrangement, adhere them in place.
- 11 Add additional ink spatters above the top, left ampersand and bottom, right ampersand.
- 12 Add a star die cut to the top, right corner of the top, right die cut. Layer a flair "you rock" button over the star.
- 13 Using small letter stickers, spell out a sub-title along the bottom of the middle, right die cut.
- 14 Add two rubber charms to the top, right corner of the bottom, right die cut.
- 15 Handwrite your journaling on a die cut label. Adhere it to the left of the left, middle die cut, tucking it underneath the die cut slightly as shown.
- 16 Add an "awesome" sticker above the journaling label and a "boy oh boy" die cut below the journaling label.
- 17 Adhere a variety of die cut stars around the page using dimensional adhesive.
- 18 Add a blue photo corner to the top, left corner of the top photo and one to the bottom, right corner of the bottom photo.
- 19 Add a tab sticker to the top edge of the top photo.
- 20 Add a "play all day" sticker to the bottom, left corner of the center photo.
- 21 Add a black chipboard arrow to the right side of the bottom photo.
- 22 Add a "original" die cut star burst to the bottom, left corner of the bottom photo.
- 23 Spell out a title below the "boy oh boy" die cut using black letter stickers.
