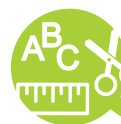

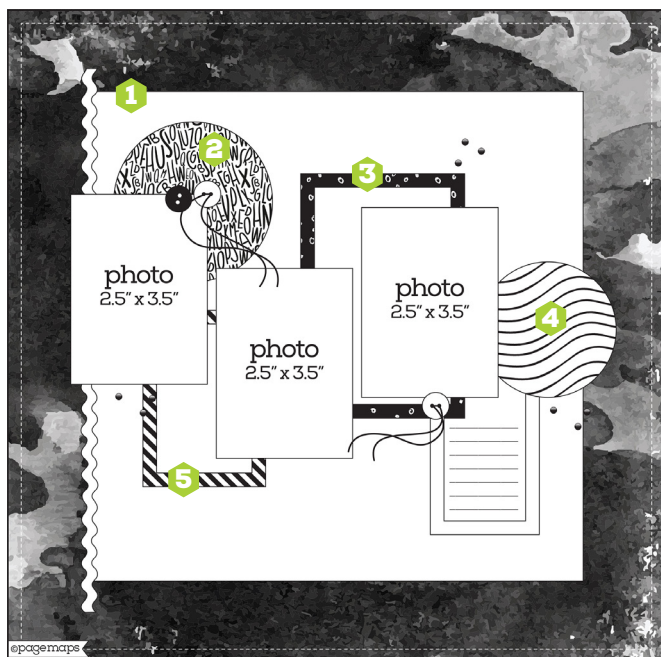

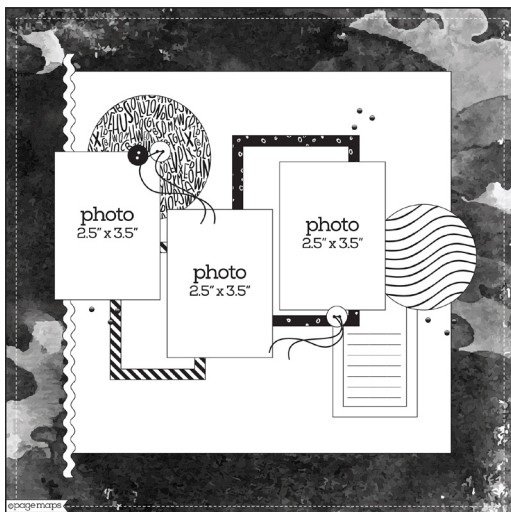


trimming dimensions

layout instructions

- Use the American Crafts black textured cardstock will be used as the base for the layout.
- Trim Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co All Together (multi colored dots) to 11.5"x11.5" and adhere to center of page.
- Trim a piece of kraft cardstock to 10"x10" and adhere to center of the dotted paper.
- Lightly sprinkle kraft cardstock with black mist, if desired.
- Trim Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Love at Home (multi colored hearts) to .5"x10.5" and adhere along the left edge of the kraft cardstock on the page.
- Using the digital frame die cuts for the class, cut three frames that each measure 2.5"x3.5", using the red patterned paper, yellow patterned paper and teal dot patterned paper from the Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co 6x6 paper pad.
- Adhere the red frame to the layout, 2.5" from the left edge of the page, 2" from the bottom edge.
- Trim the yellow frame in half. Adhere one half to the layout, 4.25" from the left edge, 2.25" from the bottom edge.
- Adhere the teal dot frame to the layout, 1.5" from the right edge, 1.5" from the bottom edge.
- Using the digital pie chart die cuts for the class, die cut two outer circles from American Crafts white cardstock that each measure 3.25" across.
- Using the digital pie chart die cuts for the class, die cut the pie pieces from 6 different papers in the Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co 6x6 paper pad. (red, yellow, black heart, navy star, white star, teal dot, patterned red).
- Arrange the pie pieces onto the white circle bases, alternating the color and pattern of the pie pieces until your pie charts are completed. Adhere to the white cardstock circles, leaving a small gap around the outer edge.
- Add machine stitching to the pie charts, if desired
- Adhere one completed pie chart to the page, 1.5" from the left edge, 2.5" from the top edge.
- Adhere the 2nd completed pie chart to the page, .5" from the right side of the page, 4.75" from the top edge.
- Add the chipboard frame (long edge up) from the Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Chipboard Designer Stickers and adhere to the page 3" from the right side of the page, 3.25" from the top edge of the page so it slightly overlaps one pie chart.
- Using foam adhesive, add a 2.5"x3.5" photo to the page, .75" from the left edge, 4.25" from the top edge of the layout.
- Using foam adhesive, add a 2.5"x3.5" photo to the page, 3.25"x5.5" from the top of the page.
- Add a Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Rubber Topped Paper Clips to the top left corner of the back of the right most photo.
- Add the word "you" using Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Chipboard Alpha Stickers inside the bottom of the frame on the page.
- Add the title "Real Life" from the Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Ephemera to the inside of the chipboard frame.
- Using Mini alphabet stamps with black ink or alphas stickers, complete the title in the chipboard frame with the word "with."
- Add a label tab from the Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Ephemera to the top left corner of the left most photo and stamp with the date.
- Add a heart die cut from the Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Ephemera to the bottom right corner of the chipboard frame.
- Add buttons and Fancy Pants Designs Family & Co Puffy Stickers as shown.
- Add journaling to white cardstock, cut into strips and adhere over open area of teal dot frame





cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .svg, .dxf, .silhouette and .png formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Pazzle, Boss Kut, etc.). If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand cut the shapes with a craft knife or scissors.
